RIVERFEST 2011

RiverFest 2011, our 21st annual music, art & environmental festival celebrating the Delaware River, will be held rain or shine on **Sunday, July 24, 2011**, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Main Street in Narrowsburg, NY. You are invited to request space for selling food or beverages. A fee of \$65 per space (\$55 for DVAA members), a certificate of insurance, and a completed application form are required by **June 3, 2011**.

REGULATIONS

- Setup begins at 8:00 a.m. Setup must be completed and vehicles cleared by 9:30 a.m. Spaces measure 10' x 10'. Food vendors may not reserve more than two spaces and must provide their own set-ups. Limited electricity is available. Please call if you need it. Vendors must provide their own extension cords.
- Vendors must remain for the duration of the show and have a representative on duty in the booth throughout the festival hours. **To avoid duplication, only those food/ beverage items named in the application can be for sale.** Exceptions need prior approval. Vendors are responsible for the display, protection, storing, and removal of their booths and cleanup of their spaces. Vendors should provide adequate protection for their booths against sun, rain and wind.
- Vendors must provide a certificate of insurance (liability) naming as additional insured the Delaware Valley Arts Alliance, PO Box 170, Narrowsburg, NY 12764.
- **A NYS food service permit must be displayed at your setup** during the event. Temporary food service permits are required (regulation by NYS Health Dept. Rules Part 14 Subpart 14-2 Section 225). They may be obtained through NYS Dept. of Health, 50 North St. Monticello, NY 12701. 845-794-2045.
